### JOURNALISM CLUB

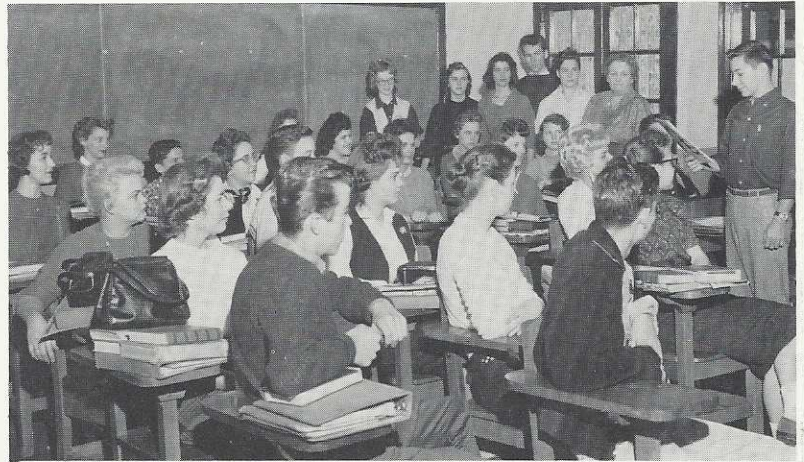

Thespians, one of Tech's honor societies especially organized for speech students, is a small but active group.

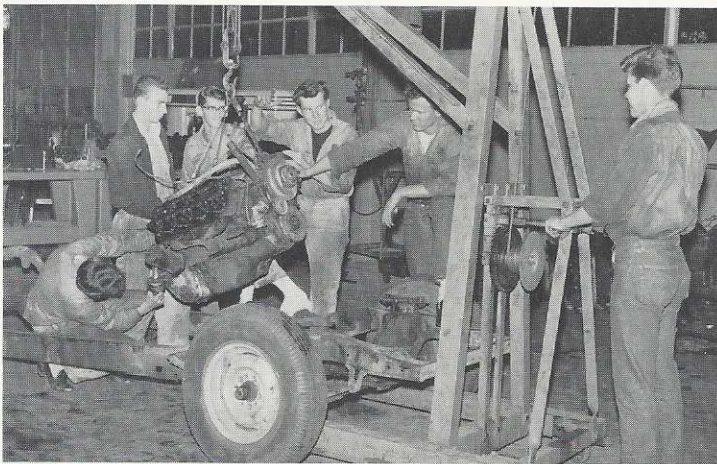

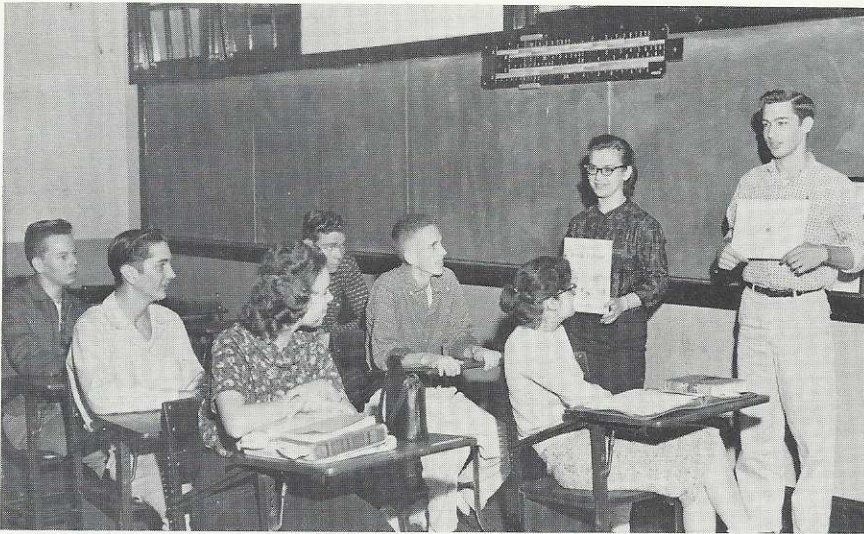
## MATH CLUB

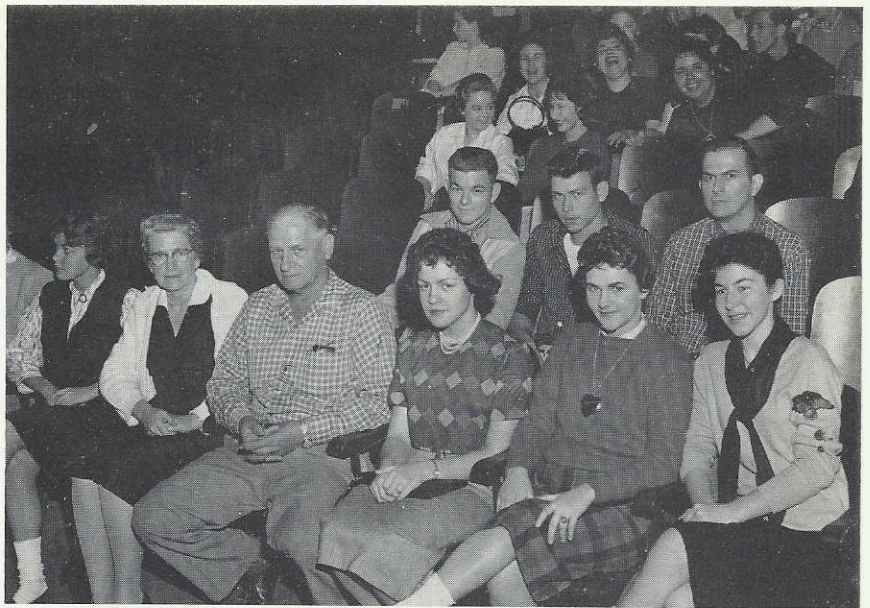
### SECRETARIAL CLUB

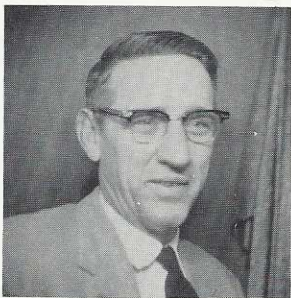

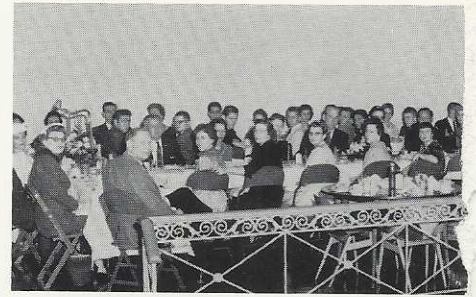

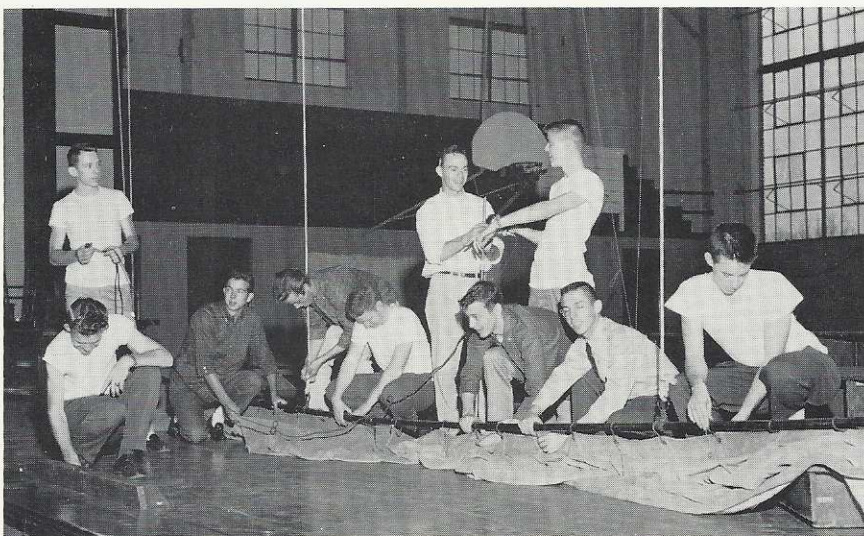

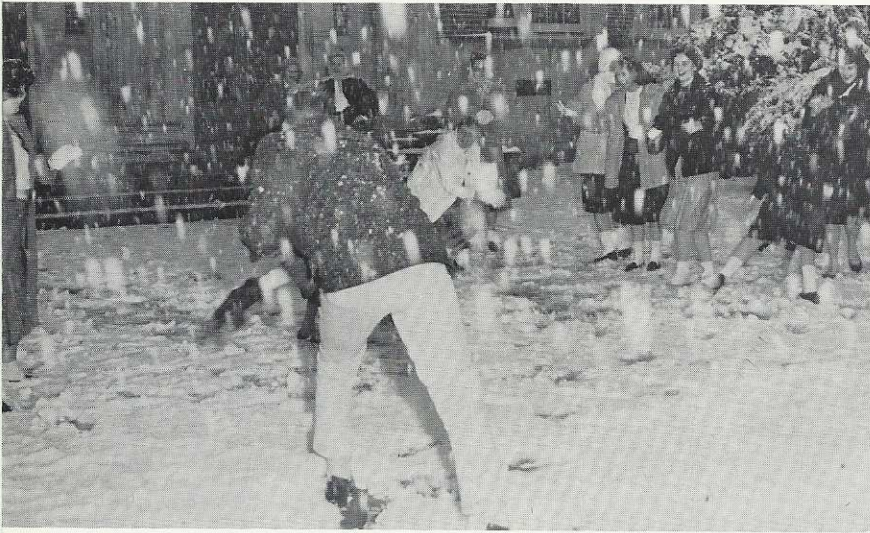
